The story in this week's lesson "**Jesus Healed a Woman and a Girl**" is from the book of Mark. Mark continued his treatise of Jesus' miraculous healings. Jesus had become well known in this region because of the miraculous things He had been doing. In Bible times, Jesus often stepped outside the traditional, cultural norms. Raising a child from death and interacting with a woman would both have been taboo in Jewish culture. **Enjoy this week's story!**

Bible Passage: Mark 5:21-43

Memory Verse: Colossians 2:9 NIV

For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form,

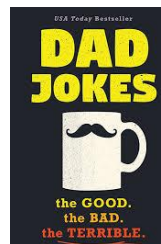
Bible Verse: John 5:21 NIV

For just as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it.

Text Truth: Because Jesus is fully God, He reigns over sickness and death.

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- “Our sense of touch was given to us by God and is very useful in our lives—all day, every day. Jesus also used the sense of touch when He healed people. We are going to read about two of those times today.”

ENJOY THIS WEEK’S STORY!

One day Jesus got in a boat and crossed the Sea of Galilee. A large crowd of people gathered near Him. A leader of the synagogue named Jairus came. When Jairus saw Jesus, he fell at Jesus’ feet and begged Him to come see his little girl. “She is dying. Come so she will get well and live.”

So, Jesus went with Jairus. On the way, Jesus was walking through a crowd of people. A sick woman was there. She had been sick for 12 years. She had spent all her money going to doctors, but instead of getting better, she was worse.



She had heard about Jesus. She walked up behind Jesus and touched His robe. She believed that if she did that, she

would be healed. The second she touched Jesus’ robe, she was healed!

Jesus knew that He had healed someone. He stopped and asked the crowd, “Who touched Me?” The woman told Jesus the truth. Jesus said, “Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace. You are healed.”

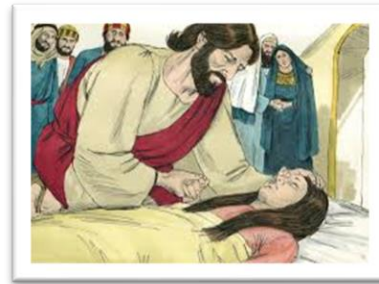
While Jesus was speaking to the woman, some people came from Jairus’ house

and said to Jairus, “Your daughter has died. You don’t need to bother the Teacher anymore.”

Jesus heard the men and told Jairus, “Do not be afraid. Only believe.”

Jesus took Peter, James, and John to Jairus’ house. A loud group of people had gathered to cry and wail. Jesus looked at the commotion and said, “Why are you making a commotion and crying? The child is not dead but asleep.”

The people started laughing at Jesus, but He sent them outside. Jesus took the little



girl’s mom and dad and His three disciples into the room where the little girl was. Jesus took her hand and said “Talitha koum.” (Little girl,

I say to you, get up.) Immediately the little girl got up and started walking around. Everyone was shocked, but Jesus said to give the girl something to eat.

When Jesus healed someone or performed another miracle, He was showing people that He is the Son of God. Because Jesus is the Son of God, He has power and authority over everything.
