The Good Samaritan

One day as Jesus was teaching, a man asked Him a question. This man had studied God's law and wanted to test Jesus. The man asked, "Teacher, what must I do to inherit eternal life?"

Jesus asked the man, **"What is written in the law?"**

The man responded, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all our soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind; and love your neighbor as yourself."


Jesus said, **"You are right. Do this and you will live."**

But the man wasn't satisfied. He wanted to justify himself. So he asked, "Who is my neighbor?" Jesus responded with a story.



"A man was traveling from Jerusalem to Jericho when he was robbed. The robbers beat him up

and left him on the road half-dead. A priest came down the road. When he saw the man, he passed him on the opposite side of the road. Next, a Levite came by. When he saw the beaten man, he also passed him on the other side of the road. A Samaritan came down the road and saw the injured man. The Samaritan had compassion and went to the Jewish



man. He bandaged the man's wounds. The Samaritan took the injured man to an inn and cared for the man's injuries. The next day the Samaritan gave the innkeeper some money. He told the innkeeper, "Care for the man. When I come back, I will reimburse you for any extra you must spend."

Jesus asked, **"Which of the men was a neighbor to the man attacked by the robbers?"**

The man replied, "The one who showed mercy."

Jesus said, **"Go and do the same."**
