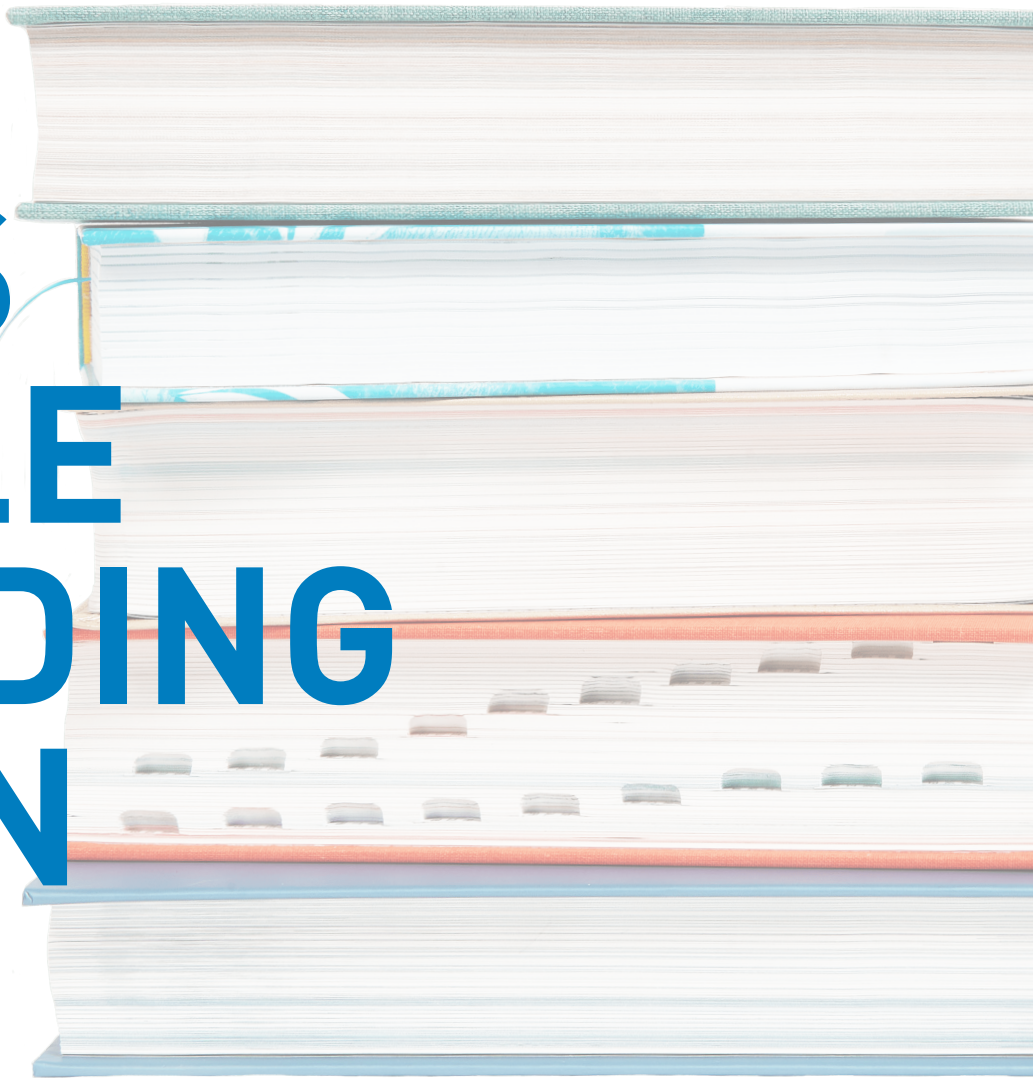

KIDS BIBLE READING PLAN



Hey, kids! Thanks for picking up this devotional reading plan. We pray that through these stories, you can begin to walk daily in God's Word. It is always important to be in God's Word and to read it for yourself. God says in Hebrews 4:12 that "the word of God is living and effective." God's Word has great importance for our lives and teaches us how to live for God each day. The verses and stories you will read will give you insight into who God is and how you can live in ways that please and honor Him.

Each day when you read a passage, take a notebook and a pencil and write down your thoughts in these four areas:

- 1** What do I think this passage **meant to the people who first read the words?**
- 2** What do I think this passage **means to me?**
- 3** What do I think this passage **is teaching me about God or Jesus?**
- 4** What do I think **I need to do based on what I learned?**

After reading your Bible, it is always a great idea to pray and ask God to reveal to you how He wants you to live based on the passages you read.

Use the selected passages below as a beginning point for daily Bible reading. Check off each passage as you read it and add other passages as you dig deep into God's Word. When you are finished, start over and see that God will show you something new each time you read His Word!
