**Text Truth:** **Listening to the Word of God should be our priority.**

**Bible Skills Spotlight:** Establish the discipline of daily Bible reading. Use other resources to enrich Bible skills and knowledge (Bible dictionary, commentary, concordance, atlas, and digital sources).

**It is important to note that this story takes place when Jesus is nearing the end of His ministry on earth and is making a long journey toward Jerusalem.**

*One day as Jesus was traveling from town to town to teach people, He came to a village called Bethany. A woman named Martha invited Jesus into her home to eat a meal. Martha had a sister named Mary. Mary sat down by Jesus' feet and began to listen to what Jesus was saying.*



*But Martha was distracted. She had many chores to do. Martha asked Jesus, "Lord, do You care that my sister has left me to do all of the work alone? Tell her to help me."*

*But Jesus said, "**Martha, Martha, you are worried and upset about many things. Mary has made the right choice, and it will not be taken away from her.**"*

*Mary understood that listening to Jesus was the most important thing she could do.*

**GRAB YOUR BIBLE AND OPEN TO THE BOOK OF LUKE Chapter 10. WE WILL BE READING VERSES 38-42**

"Which Bible division is Luke located in?"  
(Gospels)

"Before someone comes to your house, what are some things that your family does to get ready?" (clean house, straighten up, prepare food)

"What are you asked to do?"

**Read Luke 10:40**

"Why was Martha frustrated with her sister?" (Martha felt like she was doing all the work while Mary was sitting listening to Jesus.)

"In Bible times, hospitality (how we welcome someone into our home) was very important. Martha was concerned about showing hospitality and serving the food. This was not a bad thing, but it was not the best or the most important thing. Mary had chosen the most important thing— listening to Jesus."

"What are other things we choose sometimes instead of listening to the Word of God?" (gaming, streaming a favorite series, hanging out with friends) •

"These things are not necessarily wrong. However, like Mary, **listening to the Word of God should be our priority.**"

**"Remember God IS with you always and He hears your prayers."**
